Your Council has agreed that it is opposed to any further development at Gatwick Airport or Redhill Aerodrome and has written to the various bodies concerned expressing this view. We hope that residents who hold similar views will also have written. The large turnout at the Lloyd Hall Meeting in June would indicate that there is considerable opposition to these schemes but the closing date for letters was 30th June.

Your Council has also decided to investigate the possibility of alternative arrangements for clearing the ever increasing amounts of litter that appear in the village. This process may take time, and we will be discussing with Tandridge District Council, and other organisations, what options are available - and of course at what cost.
