### **CYCLE RIDE SUNDAY 20<sup>th</sup> JUNE**

We have written to the Ride Organisers as well as Tandridge District Council regarding the clearing of ALL litter from the route following this event (see Village Website [www.outwood.org](http://www.outwood.org)) and our Parish Clerk is obtaining passes from the organisers for residents who may need to access the route on the day. ### **POST BUS**

Following further telephone calls, and letter to the Management of Royal Mail, we have received a letter (from Glasgow) stating that they “have spoken to the Delivery Office Manager at Redhill and there are no plans to remove this service”. ### **EAST SURREY WHEELS 2 WORK**

This scheme aims to loan mopeds for periods of up to six months to help people (over 16 years of age) to overcome transport as a barrier to work (training or education) in areas where there is no suitable public transport and no friend or relative can provide a lift. The scheme is part of the East Surrey Rural Transport Partnership ([www.eastsurrey.org.uk](http://www.eastsurrey.org.uk)) and the funders include Surrey County Council and The Countryside Agency. ### **LLOYD HALL CAR PARK APPEAL**

This was heard at Oxted on 5<sup>th</sup> May and the decision will not be made until June. Your Parish Council were represented and had presented photographic evidence to the Inspectorate of the possibility of a future accident when 43 cars were parked on the occasion of a childrens party in December and 39 cars at a cycle race (which was well “Marshalled”) in April. A site visit was included in the proceedings.
