

## **Report of the Outwood Parish Council Meeting ~ October 2006**

In the absence of any County or Local Councillors and with no police report this month we proceeded with the Parish Councillors' reports. Councillor Frow had sent a written report in which he told us that there are to be two 'Inquiry by Design' workshops on the RAV proposals for developing Redhill Aerodrome. The dates are 14th and 29th November; 6.30 for 7pm, venue to be announced. There will also be a public exhibition on 12th and 13th January.

Planning applications and their results are now posted on the parish notice board but, of course, neighbours always receive notification, applications are publicised in the Surrey Mirror and applicants must post the notice on their gate with the details.

The Outwood Show made a fair profit and there have been a number of applications for funding various projects. The website will be updated in the near future.

The path on Dayseys Hill was discussed. The council felt that the cost of topdressing it with sand may not be viable and has decided to monitor the path to see how it fares during the winter. The sign with extra wording for the present signs is in the process of being manufactured.

Litter picking will take place in Bellwether and Gayhouse Lanes during the week beginning 20th November.

The council is anxious to use the government's proposals to lower speed limits in rural areas and had in fact already had a meeting with the police to discuss this. It is proposed that all speed limits be lowered by 10 m.p.h. apart from Brickfield Road where it should be 40 throughout. This would mean that the Community Speed Watch scheme could be used throughout the village. Members of the council would value villagers' comments within the next month or so please.

Now for the news that some parishioners have been awaiting for a very long time - the boundary changes will be official on April 1st 2007.

Finally the council wishes the Outwood Youth Club much success when it starts up on November 2nd.
